# ABOUT THE MGA

The Legacy Men's Golf Association has proudly hosted events and provided a community for its members for more than two decades at one of Middle Tennessee's finest public venues. Thanks to the support of the golf course staff, our board, and our members, we look forward to furthering our progress in elevating the player experience throughout the 2026 season.

## **Member Fees**

Member Fees for the 2026 season are \$60 and payable to John Stewart in person, via Venmo to @J\_Stew, or left in the Pro Shop for the MGA. Member Fees are due before participation, and will not be discounted if a member joins mid-season.

## **Handicap Policy**

All MGA Members are expected to post every eligible round to the USGA for an accurate representation of their handicap. Players who are found to have played an eligible round without posting to their handicap will have a round auto-posted in accordance with their current Handicap Index. We understand the desire for fun and fair competition, and appreciate your support as we continually work towards fostering such an environment.

In accordance with the regulation mentioned above, all event players must have two rounds posted within the two months or will be forced to play off their low Handicap Index from the past 12 months.

## **Pace of Play**

At all times, but especially during MGA events, groups are expected to keep pace with the group directly ahead of them. A repeated failure to uphold pace of play could result in some form of response from the MGA's Board.

## **Late/Cancellation Policy**

If a player is late, they will receive net double bogeys throughout the round until they arrive to their group. If a player cancels or does not arrive (without just cause), said player will forfeit 50% of their entry fee on their first offense, 75% on their second offense, and 100% on their third offense and beyond.

## **Tees**

Players will play from the following tee markers, outside of certain events or weather...

- Red... Ages 70+
- Gold... 55+
- White... 54 & Under

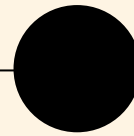
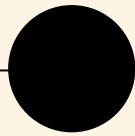
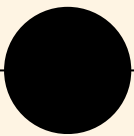
## The Barn Smoker
